COURSE OVERVIEW

Law Enforcement Agencies adopt certain methodologies in dealing with processes of entry, search and seizure. These methods and tactics are borne from experience and are proven in field situations. From time-to-time, private investigators can be called upon to support regular law enforcement when raid operations are conducted. However, raid actions are often hostile in nature and it is vital that private investigators involved, understand the basic principles of what they can and cannot do when such actions take place, as well as fully understanding how to best support and complement their law enforcement counterparts. This course is designed to provide the student with the basic understanding of the principles and methods to adopt during the planning and execution of a raid activity led by law enforcement personnel.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

This module will teach the student the fundamentals of:

- Lawful authority in various Asian jurisdictions;
- Raid preparation;
- Entry into premises;
- Searching premises;
- Exhibit seizure;
- Exhibit storage and continuity of evidence;
- Post raid client report preparation; and
- Basic Dos and Don'ts.

METHOD OF INSTRUCTION

This hands-on course takes a practical approach towards the planning and execution of raids as a civilian supporting law enforcement. Each participant will be individually assessed in relation to their competence during a number of scenarios designed to test understanding.
